

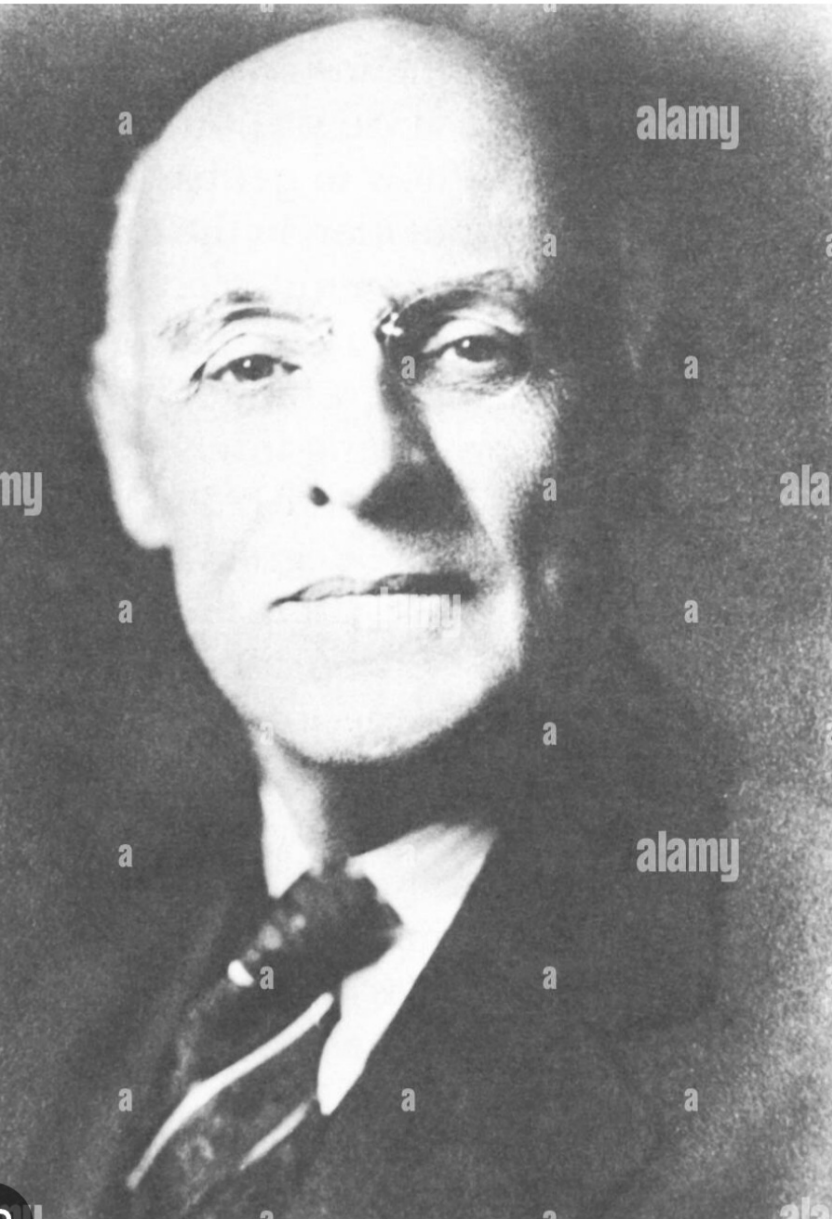

1910 The Flexner declaration: anything non-biomedical (chiropractic, natural medicine, acupuncture, midwifery) was "quackery"

Abraham Flexner

1913 Rockefeller Foundation endowed \$250M to build/fund first School of Hygiene and Public Health.

Eugenics (clean society of the "lesser" elements), the early work of the Germans, was made possible by Rockefeller support.

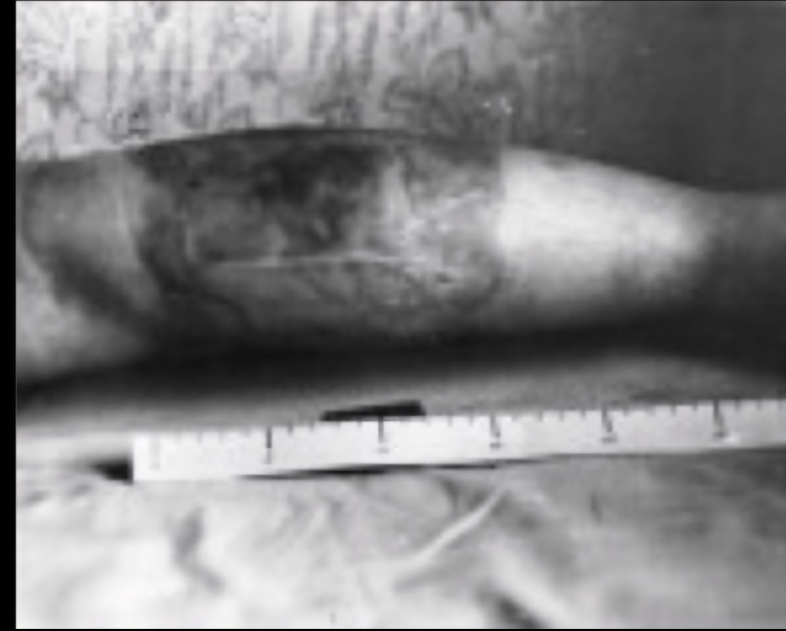
1914 Rockefeller established the General Education Board

"I don't want an education system that creates thinkers, I want an education system that creates workers." John D Rockefeller

1927 Rockefeller/Standard Oil joined with IG Farben chemical company (later to become Bayer) to create first cartel:
pharmaceuticals.

Pills are made using petroleum.

1930's Rockefeller joined with Hitler's
eugenics/hygiene movement.



German physicians conducted criminal medical experiments on concentration camp prisoners. Auschwitz.org

Farben used Auschwitz as part of its campus.



1939 "DRUG TRUST"
ALLIANCE WAS FORMED
BETWEEN ROCKEFELLER

PATENTS WHEN IT
STEALTH-BUILT THE
LUFTWAFFE.





Early '40s Farben (which became Bayer) used slave labor from concentration camps, and one of its subsidiaries, BASF, provided the poisonous gas for the gas chambers.

1941 "Our Friendship with the SS is a blessing. We have determined all measures integrating the concentration camp to benefit our company." Otto Armbrust - Farben board member overseeing the Auschwitz "project".





Charles Lord

1942 US Federally funded a study injecting an experimental vaccine into patients at an "insane asylum".

“When you give somebody a disease — even by the standards of their time — you really cross the key ethical norm of the profession.”

Arthur Caplan, director of the UPenn Center for Bioethics.

Nov 1945 – Oct 1946

The Nuremberg tribunal dissolved IG Farben into 3 parts: Bayer, BASF, and Hoescht, who for 30 years filled top chairman positions with members of the Nazi regime.



1953 CIA director, Allen Dulles, approved MK-Ultra, a top-secret program for use of biological and chemical materials and mind control experiments via electroshock, radiation, drugs, toxins, and chemicals.

1952-1959 "100 biological warfare simulations were conducted by the Army in [unsuspecting] urban and rural areas"

1950s and '60s Pesticides and insecticides were deemed "safe" by regulatory agencies, and highly processed foods were also deemed "safe" by the scientific experts.

1970's Cancers on the rise.

and expensive devices and procedures.

No funding for or research into prevention or natural medicines.
They aren't patentable. They are competition.

Laetrile - vitamin B-17 - was claimed to have no benefit and banned due to potential side effects, while highly toxic and expensive pharma treatments were exclusively promoted.

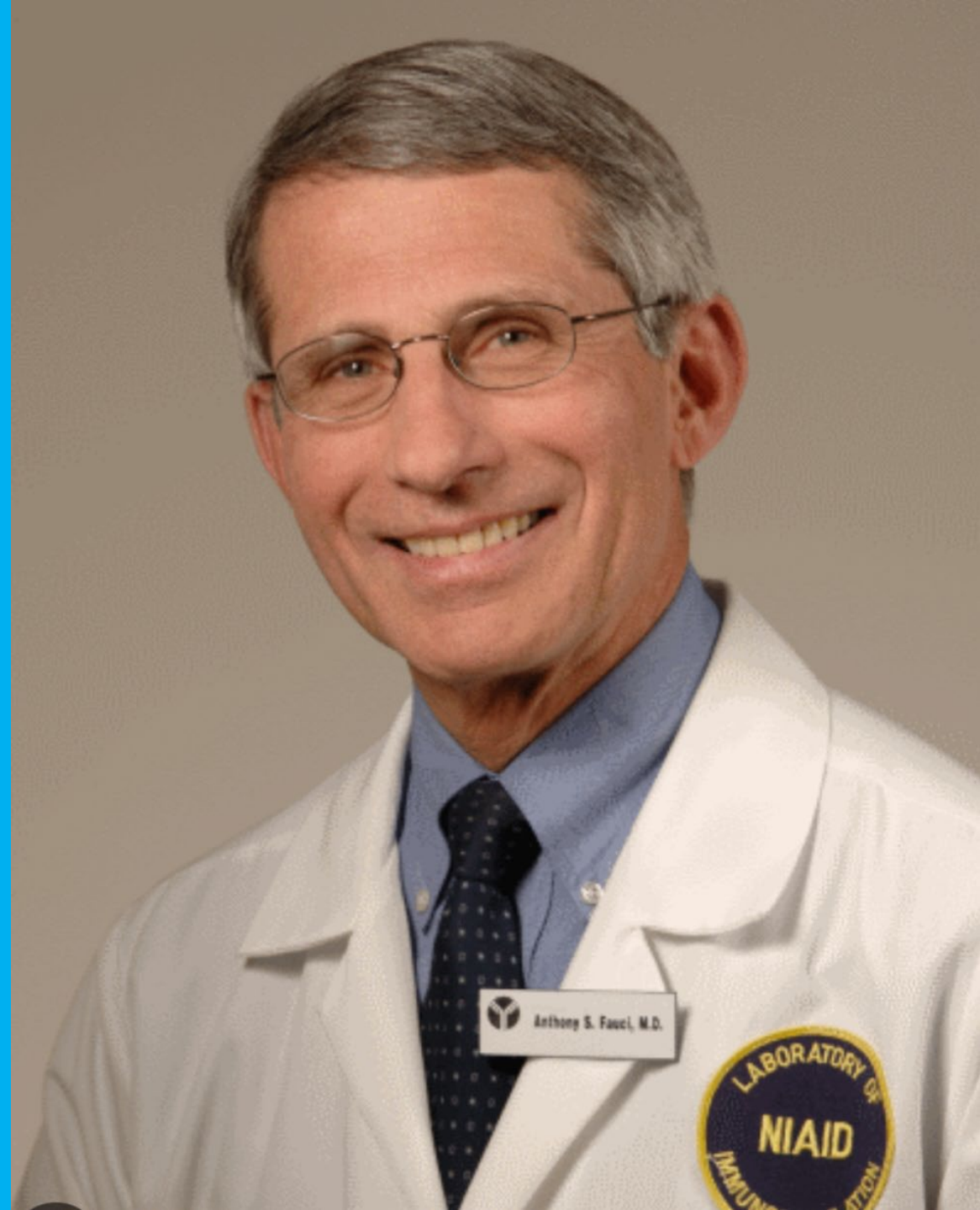

1983 The AIDS epidemic. In the May Journal of the AMA the young director of NIAID (at NIH), Anthony Fauci wrote:

"We are witnessing at the present time, the evolution of a new disease process of unknown etiology, with the mortality of at least 50% and possibly 75% to a 100% with doubling the number of patients every 6 months..."

Fauci quote con't "...The finding of AIDS in infants and children who are household contacts of patients with AIDS or persons with risk for AIDS has enormous implications..."

Stirring up fear stirs up funding. He claimed he was taken out of context.

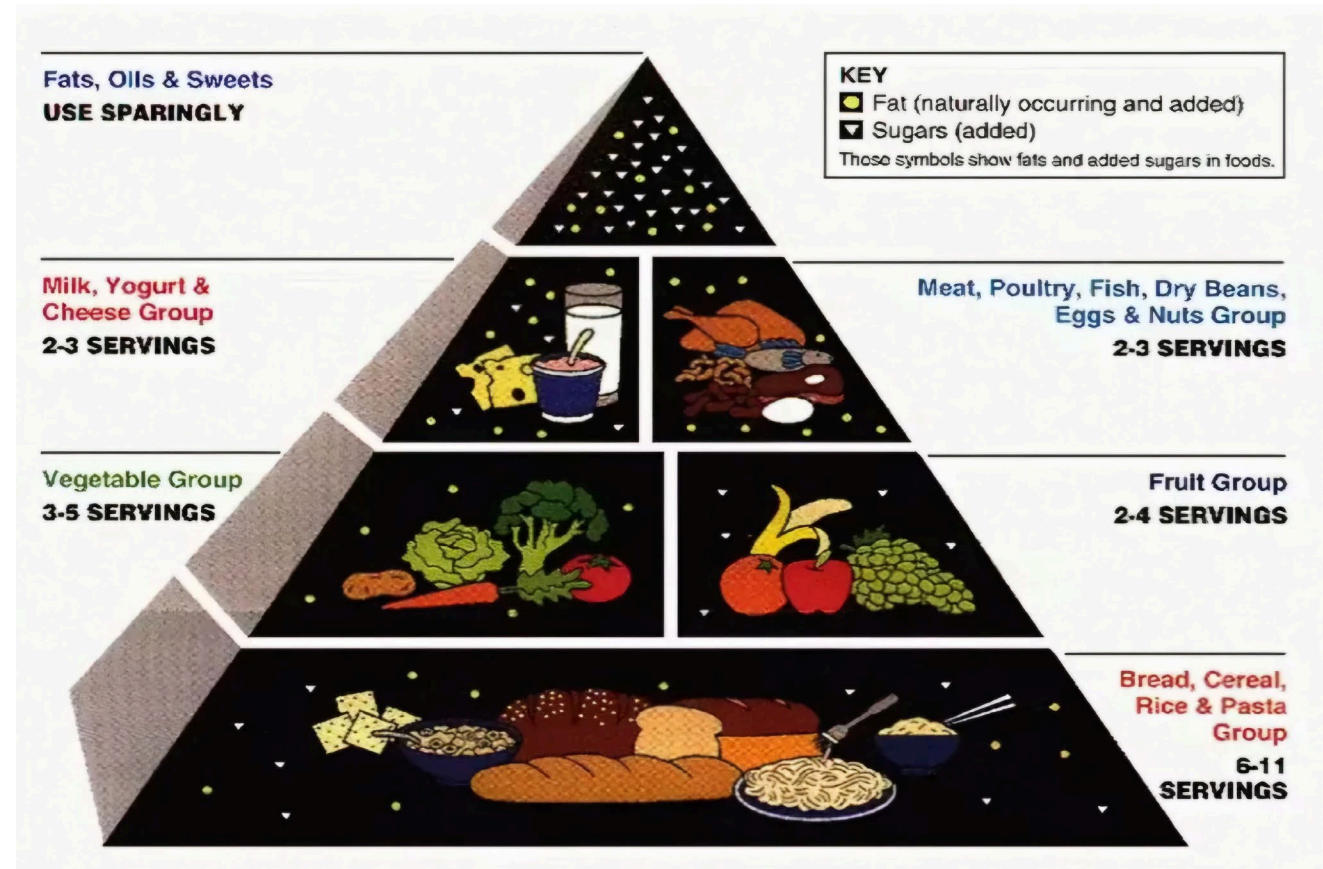


USDA and Unhealthy Foods. Highly processed foods and carcinogenic dyes and ingredients were all deemed "safe" by expert scientists.

1992 Lobbying efforts influenced the development and decades-later revision of the food pyramid. For example, the original in 1992 was later criticized for emphasizing grains and meat, and reduction of all fats.

"Even when the pyramid was being developed nutritionists had long known that some types of fat are essential to health and can reduce the risk of cardiovascular disease. Furthermore, scientists found little evidence that a high intake of carbohydrates is beneficial. After 1992 more and more research showed that the USDA pyramid was grossly flawed." Scientific American Dec 1, 2006

Mental Health

The biomedical/pharma model assumes the cause and solutions for all emotional, mental, behavioral dysfunction are biochemical or neurological, so prescription medication has steadily soared.



Too many people take too many pills

Some Stats:

6.8% increase in mental health drug prescriptions per year on average between 1998 and 2010. British Journal of Psychiatry

Antidepressant prescriptions increased by an average of 10% per year between 1998 and 2010. Cambridge University Press study

AI overview

2008- 2019 people who had any mental illness (AMI) in the past year increased from 17.7 percent/39.8 million people to 20.6 percent/51.5 million people. Approx 1 million increase per year.

2019 approximately 16% of adults (18 and older) reported taking prescription medication for mental health concerns,

From Jan 2025 10% of children ages 3-17 had current, diagnosed anxiety (9% of males and 11% of females). 4% of children ages 3-17 had current, diagnosed depression (3% of males and 6% of females)
